RESIDENTIAL HEAT PUMP WATER HEATER REBATE Program Participation Guidelines

HOMES THAT QUALIFY FOR A REBATE

- New Construction Homes qualify for one HPWH per residence.
- Site Built & Manufactured Homes qualify for one HPWH per existing residence replacing an electric water heater.
- Home *must* be permanently occupied year-round; seasonal homes or homes with part-time occupancy are not eligible.

REBATE AMOUNT

- \$300 for Qualifying any tank size Tier 1.
 - \$500 for Qualifying any tank size Tier 2 – 3.
- *Rebate(s) will not exceed 100% of total heat pump water heater purchase costs (does not cover installation costs)**

INSTALLER REQUIREMENTS

BEFORE INSTALLATION: PRE-APPROVAL

- An on-site visit is *not* required prior to installation to qualify for the rebate.
- Rebate Applications must be submitted within six (6) months of purchase to qualify.

AFTER INSTALLATION: FINAL DOCUMENTATION

- You or your contractor must submit a completed Heat Pump Water Heater Rebate Application and final invoice to Coos-Curry Electric.

QUALITY ASSURANCE INSPECTION

- Coos-Curry Electric may do a follow-up inspection of your new Heat Pump Water Heater.
- If you are chosen for an inspection, you will be contacted beforehand to schedule a day/time with a Representative of the Heat Pump Water Heater (HPWH) Program.

REBATE PAYMENTS

- Please allow 6-8 weeks for payment after receipt of all required documentation.
- All rebates will be paid in the form of a credit to an active member account.
- Please ensure to specify the correct account number in your application to where credit should be applied.
