



RESIDENTIAL PTCS AIR SOURCE HEAT PUMP REBATE Program Participation Guidelines

HOMES THAT QUALIFY FOR A REBATE

- Site-Built and Manufactured homes are both eligible.
- Upgrades include replacing an existing heat pump, adding a heat pump to a nonelectric system, replacing the heat pump portion of a ground-source heat pump system, or upgrading from zonal to air-source heat pump.
- Conversions must convert an electric forced air furnace to a high efficiency heat pump.

REBATE AMOUNT

- \$500 for qualifying Air Source Heat Pump Upgrade OR Add to System with non-electric heating system (i.e., gas/oil/propane/wood) OR Upgrade from Zonal Electric Resistance
 - \$1400 for qualifying Heat Pump Conversion from existing Forced Air Electric Furnace (only) to New Heat Pump
 - \$300 for qualifying Heat Pump Commission & Controls (This measure cannot be claimed with any other heat pump measure).
- *Rebate(s) will not exceed 100% of total heat pump purchase and installation costs**

INSTALLER REQUIREMENTS

- To qualify for incentives, heat pump ***must*** be installed and certified by an active, approved PTCS certified HVAC contractor.
- Jobs ***must*** be submitted to the PTCS database by the contractor and approved by PTCS before rebate(s) will be issued.

BEFORE INSTALLATION: PRE-APPROVAL

- An on-site visit is *not* required prior to installation to qualify for the rebate.
- Rebate Applications must be submitted within six (6) months of purchase/installation to qualify.

AFTER INSTALLATION: FINAL DOCUMENTATION

- Residential HVAC with PTCS rebate application signed by both the member & contractor
- PTCS Heat Pump Form
- PTCS Heat Pump Registry Approval
- Final Invoice

QUALITY ASSURANCE INSPECTION

- Coos-Curry may do a follow-up inspection of your new PTCS Heat Pump.
- If you are chosen for an inspection, you will be contacted beforehand to schedule a day/time with a representative of the PTCS heat pump program.

REBATE PAYMENTS

- Please allow 6-8 weeks for payment after receipt of all required documentation.
- All rebates will be paid in the form of a credit to an active member account.
- Please ensure to specify the correct account number in your application to where credit should be applied.
