Completed applications will be accepted at any CCEC office no later than 5:30 p.m. January 17, 2019 with a written essay. Interviews will be scheduled the following week.

The selected Coos-Curry Electric Cooperative, Inc.'s delegate must agree to be available to attend the NRECA Youth Tour in Washington, D.C. June 13 - 20, 2019. This is an all-expense-paid trip, with the exception of spending money.

To be eligible for the competition, students must:

- Be in the 11th grade during school year 2018/19.
- Live in the home of a parent or legal guardian who is an active Coos-Curry Electric Cooperative member living in CCEC's service area.
- Be able to participate in the tour to Washington, D. C., June 13-20, 2019.
- Submit the completed Application & Essay to CCEC **by 5:30 p.m., Thursday, January 17, 2019.** (This form is fillable PDF to make it easy to type)
- Be able to attend a personal interview (date, time and location to be determined).
- Bring a letter of recommendation from a teacher or professional source to the interview.
- The selected delegate may be asked to conduct a presentation to the CCEC Board of Directors after the trip.
- Write up a summary after the trip to be published in Ruralite Magazine.
- Your photo may be published in print material and online.
